### **SCHOOL CONTRIBUTIONS & CHARGES 2019**

Dear Parents

The Jurien Bay District High School Board has endorsed our schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2019 in accordance with the School Education Regulations 2000 as part of the School Education Act 1999. This schedule is designed to provide you with information about anticipated costs that may occur throughout the coming school year and allow you time for forward planning of the likely outlays.

The schedule is made up of the following three areas:

**1. CONTRIBUTIONS – *Payment requested at beginning of year***

Contributions have been set at \$60.00 per child. This represents an important revenue source and supplements school expenditure in the areas listed over the page. The quality of our learning programs will be maximised when all families contribute so it is vital that parents make a commitment to paying these amounts. Please note that flexible payment options (i.e. instalments) can be made by contacting the Manager Corporate Services.

**2. CHARGES FOR EXTRA COST OPTIONAL COMPONENTS – *Payment required as events occur***

Children will engage in a variety of activities associated with educational programs for which charges will be incurred. The School Board recognises the value of these types of activities and seeks to support teachers who coordinate them as part of their teaching programs.

### Important Notes – please read carefully
