OUR SCHOOL

It is our belief that the wearing of a school uniform fosters and enhances the public image of the school. It builds school pride, as well as unity and team spirit within the student body.

School uniforms foster a sense of belonging and cohesion and are shown to reduce the potential for bullying by creating a level playing field. They make getting ready for school easier, help with safety; as students are easily identifiable, and prepare students for formal scenarios later in life.



PRIMARY UNIFORM

- ◆ Wide brimmed hat, bucket hat or baseball cap. No hat no play, at all times.
- ◆ Uniform Shop supplied shorts or plain navy blue/black shorts, skirts or skorts of an appropriate length (general rule is fingers must still touch material when arms are placed at your side).
- ◆ Uniform Shop supplied long pants or plain navy blue/black bottoms, including track pants.
- ◆ Red polo shirt with blue side with embroidered logo on upper left or faction sports shirt.
- ◆ Uniform shop supplied navy blue jacket with embroidered logo or plain navy/black jacket, jumper.



SECONDARY UNIFORM



- ◆ Wide brimmed hat, bucket hat or baseball cap to be worn for all PE lessons, anytime on the oval or Basketball Court and on all outdoor class activities.
- ◆ Uniform Shop supplied shorts or plain navy blue/black shorts, skirts or skorts of an appropriate length (general rule is fingers must still touch material when arms are placed at your side).
- ◆ Uniform Shop supplied long pants or plain navy blue/black bottoms, including track pants.
- ◆ Red or Navy Blue polo shirt with blue/red side with embroidered logo on upper left or faction sports shirt or school related polo shirts/track suits (i.e. Country Week, SIDE, Year 12 Leavers, Emergency Service Cadets) may be worn.
- ◆ Uniform shop supplied navy blue jacket with embroidered logo or plain navy/black jacket, jumper.

GENERAL INFORMATION

For safety reasons we ask that all students wear closed in shoes, minimal jewellery and that all long hair is tied back or up. As a reminder, denim must not be worn to school either.

The aim of the school is to support and enable all students to comply with the school Dress Code. Our Student Services will, at most times, have a limited supply of “spare” uniforms and will work with students and parents to enable compliance with the Dress Code. These uniforms are laundered after each use.

Should a student choose not to comply with this Dress Code, even after the school has offered support, under the School Education Regulations 2000, Regulation 36, the principal of the school may apply the following sanctions:

- prevent the student from attending any activity in which the student would have been representing the school.
- prevent the student from attending or participating in any school activity which, in the opinion of the principal, is not part of the educational program (such as camps, School Ball, enrichment activities or excursions).
